This award is intended to honor volunteers to the school rather than faculty or administration who are honored in other venues.

YOUNG ALUMNI ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

The Young Alumni Achievement Award is presented to an individual who has graduated in the last twenty years who exemplifies the Collegiate traits: character, confidence, imagination and excellence through community service or his or her profession. The nominee should be at least 21 years of age.
