## COLLEGIATE SERVICE AWARD

The Collegiate Service Award will be presented to an individual—not necessarily an alumna/us—who through the years has made a significant contribution to the Collegiate community. This award is intended to honor volunteers to the school rather than faculty or administration who are honored in other venues.

## YOUNG ALUMNI ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

The Young Alumni Achievement Award will be presented to an individual who has graduated in the last twenty years who exemplifies the Collegiate traits: character, confidence, imagination and excellence through community service or his or her profession. The nominee should be at least 21 years of age.

## DISTINGUISHED ALUMNI AWARD

The Distinguished Alumni Award is given to honor a graduate or associate of the Louisville Collegiate School for outstanding achievement. The nominee may have:

- displayed extraordinary leadership and organizational ability, or;
